On the first day, participants were given an exercise. They chose a sustainability theme - sustainable tourism, sustainable water use, selective waste collection. sustainable urban development, renewable energy use - and had to produce a "promotional" video on the last day of the week. Then, for the rest of the week, the young people learned how to edit, edit a video or even edit a photo. They also took part in a series of lessons on sustainability, the dangers of social media and the very important topic of fake news.

On Wednesday, we organised a discussion forum, dividing the team into two groups. The topic of the debate was the positive and negative effects of Covid-19 on tourism and the economy. It was an extremely successful and well-attuned programme element. On Thursday, the students enjoyed an excursion to Badacsony, one of Hungary's famous wine regions, next to the popular Lake Balaton. And on the last day, the students presented the videos they had made on the chosen topics. At the end of the day, the certificates were awarded and the training was closed.
